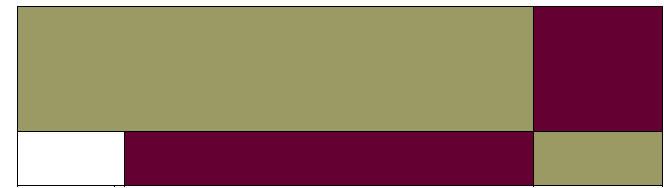

## How To Serve Your Community

1. Fill out our Community Service Form at [www.broomecouncil.net/volunteer.asp](http://www.broomecouncil.net/volunteer.asp) or call the Council at 607-724-9130
2. Make sure you have enough time to devote to fulfill the hours you need to serve.
3. Fill out our Liability Release Form.
4. Meet with one of our staff members to make a schedule for the times and days you can serve.
5. Sign in and out every time you work at the Council.
6. When your time is served, we will write a letter stating the time served.

***Remember you can always continue to volunteer after your time is up!***

## Rules and Regulations

- Please provide 24 hours notice prior to starting.
- Behave in a professional manner at all times.
- You must wear closed-toe shoes. No sandals or flip-flops.
- No shorts.
- No cell phone use unless you are on a scheduled break or it is an emergency.
- Observe all safety regulations.
- Call in if you are not able to serve on a day that you are scheduled.
- Sexual harassment and other unlawful discrimination will not be tolerated.
