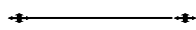

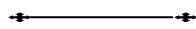

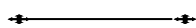

STOP Hunger Now – Meal Packaging Program
More than 1 million people do not have enough to eat.
A child dies every 6 seconds from hunger related
causes. Stop Hunger meals can help.

- ◆ Stop Hunger meals are highly nutritious, dehydrat-
ed meals comprised of rice, soy, vegetable, flavor-
ing, and 21 essential vitamins and minerals.
- ◆ Each package feeds six people at a cost of 29
cents per package.
- ◆ A team of 40 volunteers can package 10,000
meals in 2 hours.
- ◆ Our goal is to raise at least \$2,900 which will fund
supplies for 10,000 meal packages.
- ◆ Over 200,0000 packages were given to Hurricane
Sandy victims in 2013.
- ◆ Five million meals were sent to support victims of
the Haiti earthquake in 2010.
