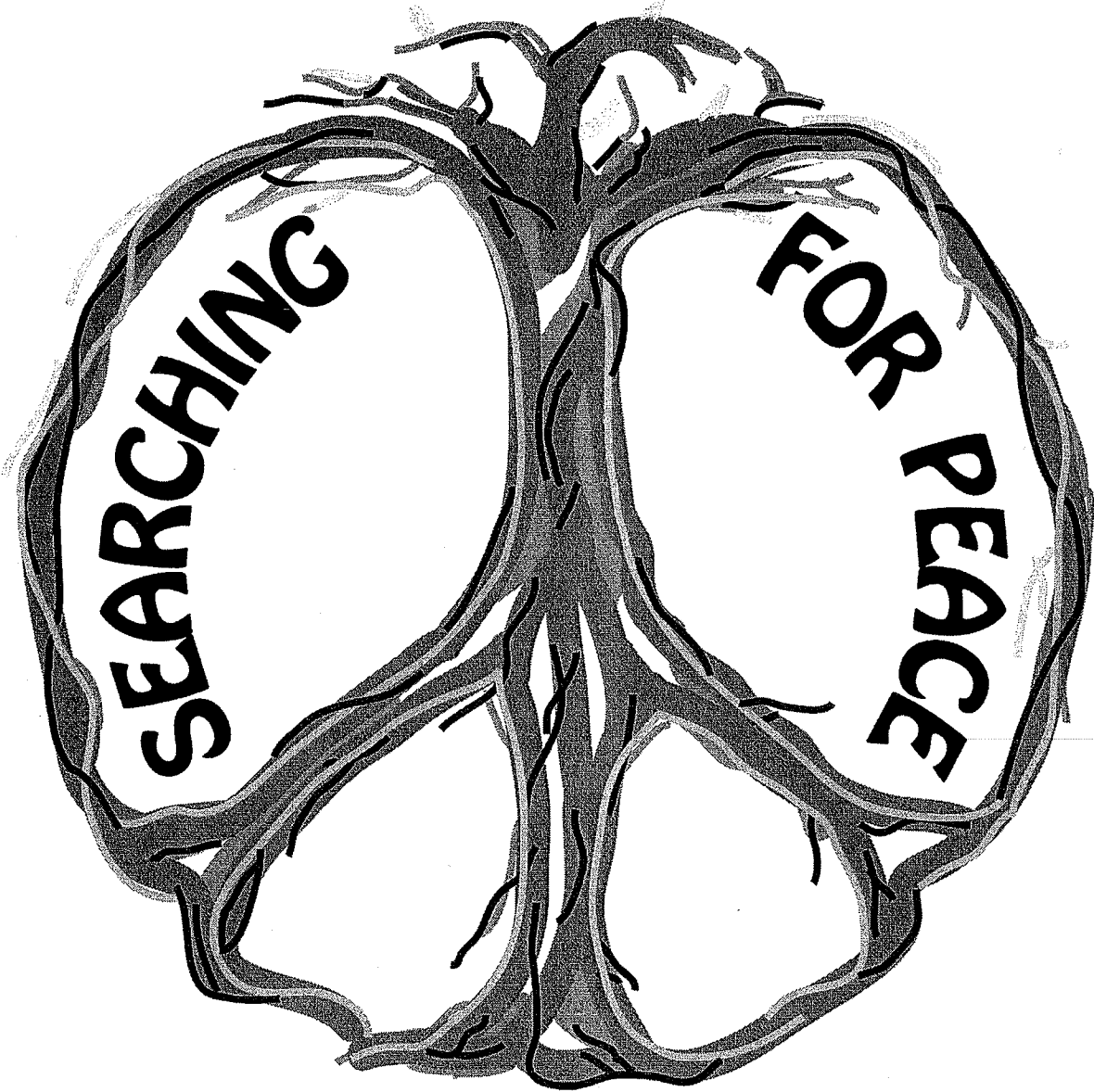

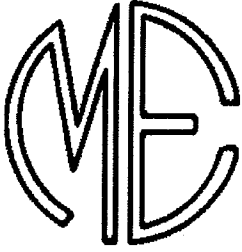

My name is Bob Graves and am the Drama Director for Maine-Endwell Senior High School's Spartan Theater Company. I am writing about our upcoming production. "*Searching For Peace*." (See poster on back). The performances last about 1 ½ hours. They will feature six very brief one act plays. The stories are "How Violence is Ended" an ancient Buddhist legend; "When the Twins Went To War" an old Russian folk tale; "The Christmas Truce" the story of a spontaneous truce on the front lines of WWI; "The Last Leaf" by O'Henry which is a story of sacrifice; "The Last Flower" by James Thurber a tale of WW XII; and "The War Prayer" by Mark Twain. In addition students and faculty will play and sing songs with peace as their central theme such as the 1908 French protest song "Le Deserteur" and "All We Are Saying Is Give Peace a Chance."

This promises to be a thoughtful night of drama and song. Please help us get the word out. Shows are November 6 & 7 at 7:30 and November 8 at 3:00.
